

CRYSTAL CATALYST BEADS: LIFE ENERGY EMITTERS

The most exciting discovery in beneficial energy jewelry since the ancient Egyptians, is a small turquoise-colored bead being produced by a Life Energy researcher in Globe, Arizona. It is called Crystal Catalyst, a substance which raises the wearer's vibratory rate stimulating their body's immune system.

Since time lost in the mists of antiquity, man has sought places, gemstones, and even built structures to raise their spiritual vibration, and promote a feeling of wellbeing. In recent years, many books have been written on the therapeutic values of gemstones and crystals. Recently, the prestigious Smithsonian Magazine featured a 20 page article on the unique electrical properties of quartz.

In brief, the article mentioned that thin quartz crystal wafers allow radio stations to stay on frequency. The D-Day invasion of World War II could not have been successful without quartz to organize radio broadcasts.

Our T.V., space communications, liquid quartz watches, telephone systems, etc. are all dependent on the unique electrical properties of quartz crystals. Quartz crystals are even being employed by one researcher in a device to instantly age wines. Although not mentioned in the article, ruby crystals are used in lasers, and concentrate light into an energy for burning steel, or for the most delicate of eye surgery.

Stone structures, circles, and mounds still remain in many parts of the world on special energy meridians. Most of the great cathedrals have also been constructed on sites which emit beneficial energy. Excavations in mounds in England have revealed planned layering of granite and organic materials to produce a life energy battery. Much has been written about the unique energy of the great pyramid at Giza. Replicas of it have been used to preserve garden seeds and milk, and to sharpen razor blades by simply leaving them in it over night.

The ancient Sumerians produced the earliest examples we have of "batteries", employing combinations of gemstones of selected types. They understood that when gems and metals of opposing polarities are combined, strong harmonic vibrations are released. They used this information to enhance the appearance and well-being of their royalty.

The ancient Egyptians carried the "battery" necklaces of the Sumerians one step farther when they developed faience. Egyptian faience, when placed against crystals and gemstones doubles the energy release, although faience releases no energy of its own. It is a true catalyst. It activates gems it touches without expending energy itself, in much the same way a prism splits visible light into its many different color vibrations without itself being changed.

Bob McKusick is a researcher, lecturer, and the modern discoverer of the "Battery Effect" of crystals and gemstones. In the early 1980's he was lecturing on the "battery effect" at the University of California at Santa Cruz. He had developed a special gemstone necklace for himself to increase his resistance to viral flu, an affliction suffered more than 12 times in the previous six months. The necklace worked, as did a number of other "batteries" that were designed for other purposes. It was this study

that led McKusick to look into Sumerian jewelry to see what made it "tick".

A friend, Oscar Branson, had just returned from Tibet and Egypt, and brought with him a number of small scarabs made of the same faience material found in King Tut's tomb. He gave one to McKusick's wife, Charmion, who wanted it added to her Sumerian type "battery" necklace. To their surprise, when the necklace was restrung with the scarab, the energy output was double. This revealed to them why the Egyptians had combined a manmade material with their precious gems and gold.

A bead can be used to cleanse and energize crystals and gemstones, but he finds one of the most exciting aspects of his work is when after three or four years, "People come up to us and tell us they are still wearing or carrying their bead, and like the Egyptian faience, they are still working. They report they just feel better."

The beads have been used on dogs and other animals suffering from arthritic conditions. All have shown marked improvement. Of course, only the body can heal itself, but the beads seem to encourage it to do that.

One of the frequent comments McKusick receives, is from people who wear a bead during travel. They require less sleep, and don't seem to be bothered by jet lag. Another comment comes from computer operators, and people who feel they are affected by fluorescent lights and other electronic pollution. The beads have been shown to neutralize most harmful low level radiations.

How are the beads made? McKusick wants to keep his special process secret, but he does reveal that the beads are made of special quartz material related to the ceramics used in super conductors. The beads have an unusual molecular structure which causes them to absorb harmful and cosmic energy, rebroadcasting it as an orgone or life energy field.

The energy from Crystal Catalyst can be measured visually using Kirlian Photography. Have a photo taken of the finger tips of your right hand. Now place a Catalyst bead in your left hand, and have the finger tips of your right hand photographed again. McKusick says the second photo will show that gaps in the auric field have been filled in. The aura will be much larger and brighter, with strong blues and greens—the colors usually associated with healing.

If a bead is placed under a cup of coffee, it will change the flavor in about 4 minutes. Placed against a beaker of water for a few minutes it will change the pH. The effects can also be measured with kinesiology, or an E.E.G.

Since 1984, McKusick has conducted research with this material. He has developed a modern product which he calls a Crystal Catalyst Bead. Like Egyptian faience, it is a catalyst material for crystals and gemstones, but it is much more powerful than the Egyptian material. One or two beads emit more beneficial energy than an entire Egyptian necklace, or a 35 foot pyramid.

McKusick states, "When you wear a bead against a crystal or gemstone, it greatly increases the energy release. Worn by itself, the bead tends to clear negativity. Most people report that they just feel better and have more energy."
